1. The rate for transport of foodgrains etc., is on the basis of net weight of food grains, which includes all taxes , duties, cess etc.,

2. No Separate remuneration will be payable for part of gunnies as the remuneration therefor shall be deemed to be included in the rates for transport of net weight of foodgrains.
3. The transport charges are payable for the distance covered by loaded lorries/any other vehicle & not for distance covered on return journey or from garage, to the place of loading or back to garage. Payment on net weight basis envisaged in the note above applies to handling operations also.
4. Transport charges shall be payable on actual distance certified by the constituted committee as per the slab rates.
5. The distance will be reckoned as fixed by the chief Engineer, PWD, or any officer nominated by him or by the Managing Director, Karnataka State Warehousing Corporation or Officer nominated by FCI or checked by an officer acting on his behalf.
6. No compensation shall be admissible to the contractors in respect of the detention of trucks/any other vehicle at godowns railheads/railway siding or any other loading/unloading points or any other places unless such detention be of extra ordinary kind and the decision of the Managing director, Karnataka State Warehousing Corporation on all such claims shall be final both as regards the admissibility and the amount if any compensation.
7. No compensation shall be admissible to the contractors on account of non availability of work sufficient to engage the number of trucks/carts any other transport vehicle/labour specified in any programmed issued by the Managing director, Karnataka State Warehousing Corporation on an officer acting on his behalf.
8. The weight of bags of foodgrains etc, loaded/unloaded into from trucks/carts/or any other vehicles/wagons at the railheads godowns other loading/unloading points shall be worked out on the basis of cent percent weighment if bags are non standardized and on a check weighment of percentage of bags not exceeding 10 %, if bags are standardized, before being loaded/unloading points etc., The weight of bags can be arrived at, either by weighing the entire load loaded over the lorry weigh bridge wherever available and deducting the tare weight of the lorry or by means of weighment over platform/beam scales or bags at the time of the loading or unloading.
9. No separate remuneration shall be paid for collecting, bagging and removal of process waste i.e. chaff etc.,

10. The rate for item-5 of the schedule of rates is applicable to godowns situated at considerable distance from the railway siding in the same premises which have been indicated in the invitation to tender (under place of operation) and in the general information furnished in appendix-I. This rate includes the remuneration for loading into and unloading from trucks and will be paid in addition to the rate fixed for service item No.3 or 4 when the Managing director, Karnataka State Warehousing Corporation or an Officer acting on his behalf is satisfied that the trucks are actually engaged for carrying the bags from the railway siding. The decision of the Managing director, Karnataka State Warehousing Corporation regarding the admissibility of this claim, shall be final and binding on the contractors.

Note:II

No charges other than those mentioned above shall be payable in respect of the services described in Part-I & Part –II the schedule of services or any other duties, services & operation which are auxiliary and /or incidental to the principal services. Payment on net weight basis envisaged in the note above applies to handling operations also.

Note:-III

The schedule of rates for services given under appendix VI shall be applicable not only for foodgrain but also for the commodities like cement & other notified commodities.

APPENDIX “VI-PART”B”

(Fertilizer stock)

SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY THE CONTRACTORS FOR TRANSPORTATION AND HANDLING OF FERTILISERS AND OTHER NOTIFIED COMMODITIES.

I. RECEIPT, DESPATCH BY ROAD:

The contractor shall unload the bags of fertilizers etc, from the Trucks and stack them to the required height in the warehouse method. They shall perform reverse operations whenever directed. The item includes the operation like collection of sweepings, Re-bagging, stitching of bags.

II. STANDARDISATION:

The contractors shall, with their labour and scales and under their supervision, standardize such No. of bags of fertilizers etc., to the prescribed weight at the godowns.

The terms standardisation includes re-bagging also and Carrying bags from stacks to weighing scales cutting open the mouth of the bags putting bags on the scale putting in or taking out grains, fertilizers etc, from each bag, as may be necessary in order that each bag contains the standard weight food grains/fertilizers etc., as may be fixed by the Officer of the corporation (or his representative) removing the bags from the scales, Re-stitching the bags with at least 16 stitches on each bag doing katcha stacking inside or outside the godown, stitching as and when necessary, carrying the standardized bags and stacking them upto the required height in the Warehouse method or loading into wagon, trucks or any other vehicle as directed. When standardized bags are not required to be restacked, or loaded such bags shall be left in a countable position on the floor of the godowns. The standardized bags should be stacked in the same godown or any other godown as directed by the Officer of the Corporation or his representative. In all such cases, payments will be made for actual net weight of the No. of standardized bags got after standardization. Filling empty gunnies with loose grains/fertilizers etc. Carrying them to the scales and bringing them to the standard weight, stitching the mouth with at least 16 stitches and stacking/dispatching or delivering as required, bundling of Empty Gummies in the required manner after standardization, cleaning, drying aerating operations and making a standard bag whenever necessary.

III: REBAGGING:

The contractor shall rebag loose grains or the contents of unserviceable bags into new bags supplied by the Corporation. Rebagging shall be deemed to include breaking the stacks, emptying contents of unserviceable gunnies, making a standard bag if necessary, filling the new bags upto a prescribed weight, stitching them, doing katcha stacking, inside or outside the godowns as and when necessary and stacking them upto required height or delivering /dispatching as directed.

IV: CLEANING:

The contractor shall, as and when required with their own labour, clean the fertilizers/sweepings etc., cleaning shall be deemed to include re-stacking the bags, weighing them, ascertain precleaned weight, carrying them to the place assigned for cleaning and sub stacking of such process as winnowing etc., removing cleaned through the sieves for other method of cleaning, as cleaning by machine etc., removing cleaned grain, filling the grain in bags, by weighing them to the standard weight, prescribed by the officer of the corporation or his representative. Stitching of bags firmly with atleast 16 stitches and carrying the standardized bags and stacking them upto the required height, or loading/delivering them as directed. Payment will be made only for the number of bags received after cleaning and standardization. No separate payments for bags filled with refractions will be made.

V: RECONDITIONING:

The bags damaged in transit, received in wet and caked up condition shall be segregated at the time of receipt and cut opened and shade aerated by the Contractor's labourers. During the process of shade aeration the lumps of caked granules should be picked out and separated. After a few days of shade aeration, the granules should be rebagged, weighed and standardized and stenciled.

VI: DRYING OF DAMAGED FERTILISERS ETC.

The contractors shall undertake drying of damaged fertilizers etc, whenever required, Drying shall be deemed to include carrying fertilizers etc., from stacks or any where also from the godown cutting open the mouth of the bags spreading the fertilizers etc., inside or outside the godown and after drying, making them into standard bags filling loose granules into empty gunnies upto a prescribed weight, stitching and stacking the bags in the same or another godown upto the required height or loading /delivering them as directed. If weightment is required to be done before cutting open the bags, it will be paid for separately, payment under this service will be made only for the number of bags received after drying and standardization.

VII: STENCILLING:

The depositors may require stenciling the bags with their stencil marking before standardization of refilling or for any other reason. In such cases the contractors should carry out the stenciling through their Labour as directed, payments for stenciling of bags is as per the rates fixed at Appendix (V, VI & VII).

VIII: BUNDLING OF EMPTY GUNNIES:

The contractors shall collect the empty gunnies released after various operations rebagging, cleaning etc., and bundle and stitch them into bundles of 25 or 50 each as directed by the officer of the Corporation, or his representative. The bundles shall be neatly made to allow verification, and the twine required for tying or stitching the outer surface of the bundles shall be supplied by the contractors. The bundles so made shall be carried to the place assigned for storage of empty gunnies and stacked in accordance with the instructions of the officer of the Corporation or his representative. Remuneration for this service shall be deemed to be inclusive of the cost of twine required to be supplied by the contractors.

IX: RESTACKING AND DESTACKING:

The contractor shall arrange for turning of the bottom bags to the top and top bags to the bottom or for lifting of bags from one stack and depositing in another stack neatly whenever rearranging or restacking as such is required. The operation shall be restricted to destacking only if so required. If restacking or destacking is done purely to rectify the defect in stacking earlier done by the contractor's labour no charge shall be payable.

X: UPGRADING OF STOCKS:

Upgrading of stocks includes destacking, cleaning, mixing, weighing, stitching the bags stacking them in the godown or loading them into trucks as directed by the Warehouse in charge.

XI.a) SHIFTING OF STOCKS WITHIN THE GODOWN.

The contractor shall as and when required, remove the bags from one stack in the godown irrespective of the distance and restack in the same godown to the required height.

b) FROM ONE GODOWN TO ANOTHER.

The contractor, shall as and when required, shift stocks from one godown, to another irrespective of the distance within municipal limits and re-stack them in the godown up to the required height. This will include destacking, transporting unloading and stacking in the godowns to the required height.
